Cisco announces the end-of-sale and end-of-life dates for the Cisco Jumpstart Appliance for Cisco Prime Network Registrar 9.0, 9.1, and IP Express. The last day to order the affected product(s) is July 20, 2020. Customers with active service contracts will continue to receive support from the Cisco Technical Assistance Center (TAC) as shown in Table 1 of the EoL bulletin.
