

End-of-Sale and End-of-Life Announcement for the Cisco TelePresence Management Suite Provisioning Extension

Cisco announces the end-of-sale and end-of-life dates for the Cisco TelePresence Management Suite Provisioning Extension. The last day to order the affected product(s) is May 2, 2019. Customers with active service contracts will continue to receive support from the Cisco Technical Assistance Center (TAC) as shown in Table 1 of the EoL bulletin. Table 1 describes the end-of-life milestones, definitions, and dates for the affected product(s). Table 2 lists the product part numbers affected by this announcement. For customers with active and paid service and support contracts, support will be available under the terms and conditions of customers' service contract.

This announcement is for the TMS Provisioning Extension, including Smart Scheduler, and CMR provisioning via Cisco Conductor. Telepresence Management Suite (TMS) and Extensions for Microsoft Exchange (TMS-XE) are not included in this announcement.
