



Cisco Identity Services Engine Software Version 1.4

Cisco announces the end-of-life dates for the Cisco Identity Services Engine (ISE) Software Version 1.4 software.

Starting Sep 30, 2017 only sev1 and security vulnerability issues will be addressed for ISE Software Version 1.4 and 1.4.X releases.

Software maintenance support for 1.4 and 1.4.X releases end on **September 30, 2018**. No patches or maintenance releases will be provided for ISE 1.4 and 1.4.X releases after that date.

Cisco support for ISE Software Release 1.4 and 1.4.X will end on September 30, 2020.

Software maintenance requires an active service contract.
