

# Secure Endpoint Linux Connectors exclusions in F-Secure 11.10.68

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## Introduction

Some antivirus products need to be configured to be compatible with the Secure Endpoint Linux connector.

## Secure Endpoint Linux connectors exclusions in F-Secure 11.10.68 on CentOS 7.4.1708

1. Configure F-Secure command line for standalone mode.
2. Configure F-Secure to exclude `/opt/cisco/amp` and all sub-directories from scanning.
3. Configure F-Secure to add file-access operations by the following programs to an allow list:  
`/opt/cisco/amp/bin/ampdaemon/opt/cisco/amp/bin/ampupdater/opt/cisco/amp/bin/ampcli/opt/cisco/amp/bin/ampsigncheck/opt/cisco/amp/bin/ampsupport`
4. Configure Secure Endpoint to exclude the following directories and sub-directories: `/etc/opt/f-secure/opt/f-secure/var/opt/f-secure`
