## Locate Serial Numbers

### From the GUI

For the Email Security Appliance (ESA) and Web Security Appliance (WSA), navigate to **Monitor/Reporting > System Status**

For the Security Management Appliance (SMA), navigate to **Centralized Services > System Status**

## Physical Access (Hardware)

For hardware models (x70, x70, x80, x90, x95, etc) you see a sticker on the rear-panel that contains the serial number. In some cases, on newer models, you see a pull-tab on the front panel which can also show the serial number.
