Objective

A certificate is an electronic document used to secure a VPN.

This document explains how to manage certificate settings on the RV110W.

Procedure

Generate a New Certificate

Step 1. Use the router configuration utility to choose **VPN > Certificate Management** and then click the **Generate a New Certificate** radio button.

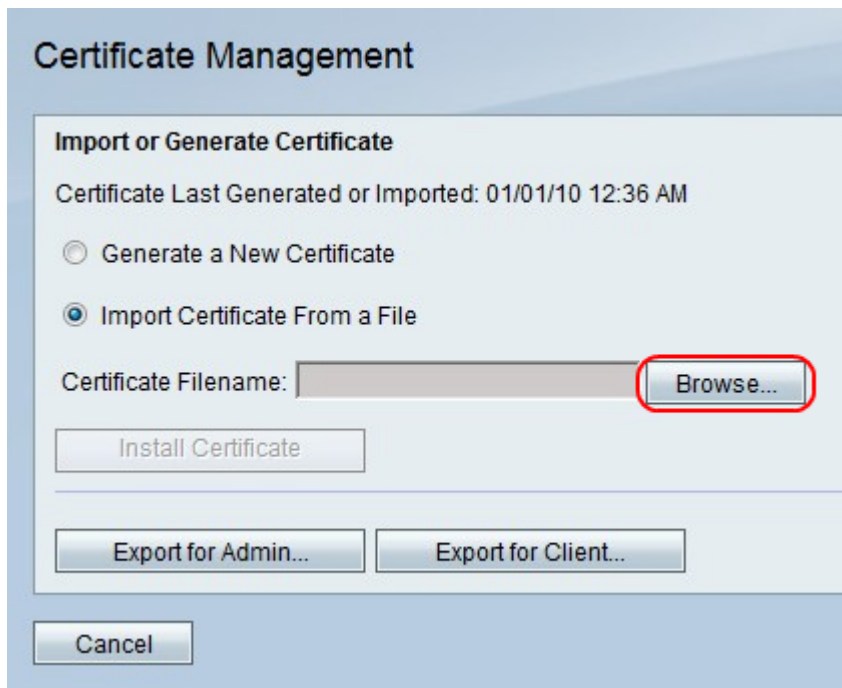

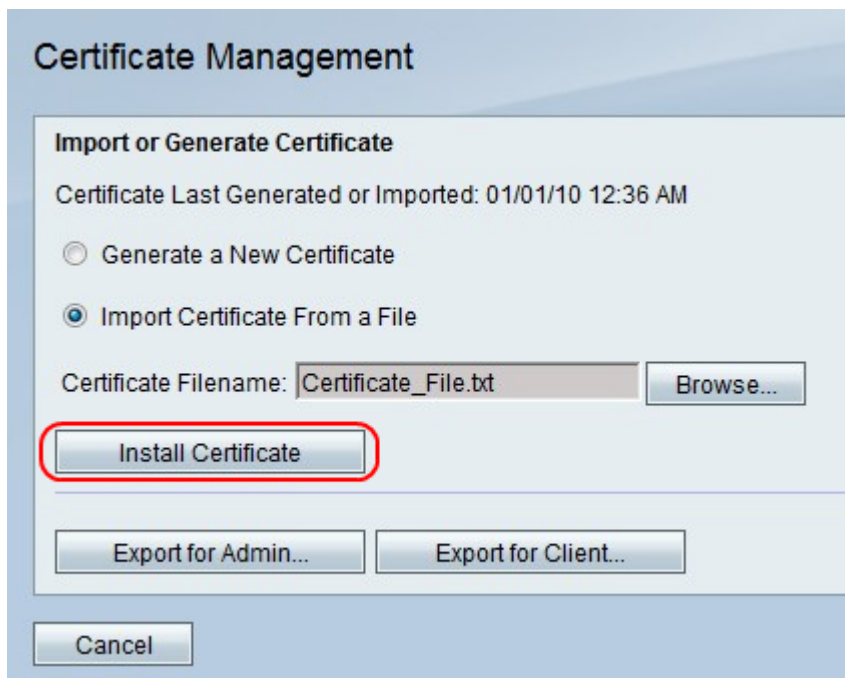
