

Vérification de la multidiffusion native dans le fabric d'accès SD

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Introduction

Ce document décrit comment vérifier la multidiffusion native dans le fabric SD-Access (SDA).

Conditions préalables

Exigences

Cisco vous recommande de prendre connaissance des rubriques suivantes :

- Transmission IP (Internet Protocol)
- Protocole LISP (Locator ID/Separation Protocol)
- Mode intermédiaire PIM (Protocol Independent Multicast)

Composants utilisés

- C9000v sur Cisco IOS® XE 17.10.1
- Cisco Catalyst Center Version 2.3.5.3

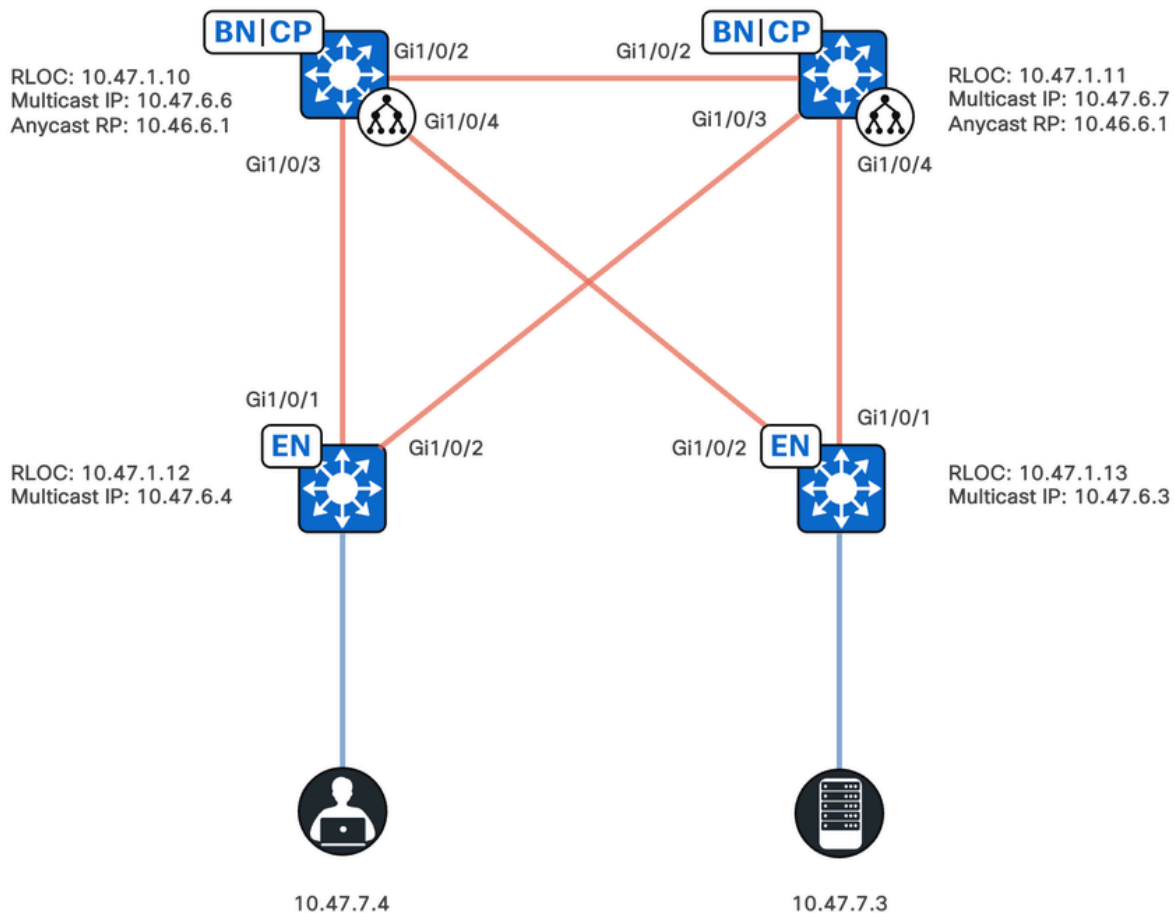
Informations générales

La multidiffusion native SDA est une forme de multidiffusion de superposition, qui est utilisée pour transporter le trafic de multidiffusion entre les périphériques de fabric, encapsulant le trafic de multidiffusion dans un autre groupe de multidiffusion. La multidiffusion native peut acheminer le trafic de multidiffusion entre les sources et les récepteurs qui se trouvent dans le même VLAN ou dans un VLAN différent (la multidiffusion du même VLAN peut être acheminée). Le trafic de multidiffusion entre les sources et les récepteurs sur le même périphérique de fabric (FE) n'est pas transféré à l'aide de la multidiffusion de superposition (encapsulation VXLAN), mais est acheminé localement par le FE. La multidiffusion native ne peut pas acheminer le trafic de multidiffusion pour les groupes qui correspondent à 224.0.0.0/24 ou à une durée de vie (TTL) =1, ceux-ci sont gérés via l'inondation de couche 2 (L2). La multidiffusion native peut être configurée pour transférer n'importe quelle multidiffusion source (ASM), une multidiffusion spécifique source (SSM) ou une combinaison des deux. La multidiffusion native repose sur la multidiffusion sous-jacente.



Remarque : les commandes de plate-forme (fed) peuvent varier. La commande peut être "show platform fed <active|standby>" ou "show platform fed switch <active|standby>". Si la syntaxe notée dans les exemples ne s'analyse pas, essayez la variante.

Topologie



Topologie du réseau

Dans cette topologie :

- Les ID de localisateur distant (RLOC) 10.47.1.10 et 10.47.1.10 sont colocalisés à n'importe quelle frontière et fonctionnent également comme point de rendez-vous anycast (RP) avec le protocole MSDP (Multicast Source Discovery Protocol) entre les deux dans le réseau virtuel (VN) ou le routage et le transfert virtuels (VRF).
- 10.47.1.12 et 10.47.1.3 sont des noeuds FE
- 10.47.7.4 est le récepteur de multidiffusion
- 10.47.7.3 est la source de multidiffusion
- 239.0.0.5 est l'adresse de destination du groupe de multidiffusion (GDA)

Configuration

Nous supposons que Cisco Catalyst Center est utilisé pour provisionner le fabric SDA avec les paramètres suivants :

- Implémentation du mode de réplication en multidiffusion native
- Le mode multidiffusion est Any Source Multicast (ASM)
- Anycast Rendezvous Point (RP) avec le protocole MSDP (Multicast Source Discovery

Protocol) configuré sur les frontières colocalisées en tout lieu

- La multidiffusion sous-jacente a été configurée manuellement ou dans le cadre de l'automatisation LAN initiale. La multidiffusion native repose sur la multidiffusion sous-jacente pour fonctionner correctement.

FHR (S, G) Création

La source de multidiffusion, 10.47.7.3, envoie des paquets de multidiffusion UDP à 239.0.0.5. Vérifiez que les protocoles IPDT (IP Device-Tracking), CEF (Cisco Express Forwarding) et RPF (Reverse Path Forwarding) pointent correctement vers la source de multidiffusion. Vérifiez également que l'interface SVI de la passerelle Anycast est le routeur désigné PIM (DR) pour ce segment.
